

**Jubilee Year of Mercy** January 3, 2016  
**The Epiphany of the Lord**  
In this *Jubilee Year of Mercy*, Epiphany celebrates God's mercy shining on the magi from a guiding star. Their kingdoms were far from Jerusalem, their religions far from God's covenant with Israel. At first the star led the magi to Jerusalem, where they could "recalculate" their quest with the help of God's own "GPS," the Jewish scriptures. How challenging and humbling for the magi to discover that they would find the world's Messiah not in a palace but with a poor couple in an insignificant village. That's where God's mercy, shining in the star, led the magi to worship Jesus, the Prince of Peace. Today the magi invite us to "recalculate" our life's journey during this Jubilee Year—to follow the star of God's mercy along the way of humble love, to discover a renewed personal relationship with Jesus ourselves and so become "guiding stars" leading other seekers to find Jesus, too.

**Año Jubilar de la Misericordia** 3 de enero de 2016  
**La Epifanía del Señor**

En este *Año Jubilar de la Misericordia*, la Epifanía celebra la misericordia de Dios brillando sobre los reyes magos desde la estrella que los guía. Sus reinos estaban muy lejos de Jerusalén, sus religiones muy lejos de la alianza de Dios con Israel. Al principio la estrella guió a los magos a Jerusalén en donde ellos podrían "recalcular" su búsqueda con la ayuda del propio "GPS" de Dios, las Escrituras judías. Que humilde y consternado debió ser el momento en que los magos vieron al Mesías del mundo no en un palacio sino con una pareja pobre en un pueblito insignificante. Ahí es donde está la misericordia de Dios, brillando en la estrella que guió a los magos a adorar a Jesús, el Príncipe de la Paz. Hoy los reyes magos nos invitan a "recalcular" nuestro camino de vida durante este Año Jubilar, siguiendo la estrella de la misericordia de Dios a lo largo del camino de amor humilde, para descubrir una relación personal renovada con Jesús hacia nosotros mismos para que podamos convertirnos "estrellas guías" dirigiendo también a otros buscadores a encontrar a Jesús.

## **From the Pastory's Desk .... We have come to adore the King!**

This is the feast of the epiphany - the showing or manifestation - of Jesus to the rest of the world. The promises of God to the people of the first covenant always included the promise that their special and gifted relationship with God would extend to the ends of the earth. No one could have imagined how that would happen.

We all love the Nativity story through the eyes of Luke. This story, through the eyes of Matthew, introduces us to Magi - astrologer types, who are really seers, or "wise men" in the sense that they are seeking wisdom with open minds and hearts. They are clearly non-Jews.

The Magi pay attention to the stars and when they see something special, they sense there is meaning in that event. Too often we aren't that open to see a new light, a new message, a clear call, to pay attention. The Magi follow the light. Their following leads them to an encounter with Herod. Their consulting with him leads them to Bethlehem, where the light has settled. We sometimes fail to consult the tradition and learn where to go to find the light. Unfortunately, the Herod they meet is also very duplicitous. He's two-faced, with a divided, selfish, jealous heart. He isn't interested in finding the new light. He wants to surprise it - to destroy it. At times, we are guilty of duplicity ourselves - or at least our hearts can be divided. We want to follow, but we are something threatened or fearful of losing something we want to hold on to. At our worst, we can even surprise or destroy the light.

The Magi find the Holy Family. They come prepared to do this newborn homage. They bring gifts for a king, for a God, for someone who will suffer. They thought about this. Too often, we don't come to this invitation to see the light with any gifts which represent our faith. And, so we don't proclaim with our lives that we believe Jesus is our Lord and God, that he is the one who, in this gospel story, will die for our sins. We can only imagine what Mary and Joseph experienced in this revelation to those far away Magi and to the gifts they bring to honor this child of theirs.

When we seek, find and honor Jesus' gift to us, our gratitude fills us with joy. And, that joy, and our way home, is different. It is new. It is renewed with a deep trust that God is with us. God can redeem, bring mercy and healing, reconciliation and redemption, to every evil - light to every darkness.

This year's epiphany of his many mercies to us -in the beginning of the Year of Mercy- can help guide us for the rest of our journey. How blessed our life can be because it has been made known to us that there is a light for our darkness! In the midst of the "thick clouds" covering us - our family and friends; our countries; our world - "the Lord shines." God bless you, Fr. Oscar

## **Del escritorio del Sr. Cura... !Hemos venido a adorar al Rey!**

Esta es la fiesta de la epifanía -la proyección o manifestación- de Jesús al resto del mundo. Las promesas de Dios a la gente del primer pacto siempre incluían la promesa de que su relación especial y dotado con Dios se extendería hasta los confines de la tierra. Nadie podría haber imaginado lo que iba a suceder.

A todos nos gusta la historia de la Navidad a través de los ojos de San Lucas. Esta historia, a través de los ojos de San Mateo, nos presenta a los Reyes Magos - tipos astrólogo, que son realmente videntes, o "sabios" en el sentido de que se buscan sabiduría con mentes y corazones abiertos. A veces no somos capaces de consultar a la tradición y aprender a dónde ir para encontrar la luz. Por desgracia, Herodes los engaña. Él es de dos caras, con una, egoísta, celoso corazón dividido. Él no está interesado en la búsqueda de la nueva luz. Quiere desaherse de ella – quiere destruir a Jesús. A veces, somos culpables de la duplicidad de nosotros mismos - o por lo menos nuestros corazones se pueden dividir. Queremos seguir, pero somos algo amenazado o temeroso de perder algo que queremos que agarrarse. En nuestro peor, incluso surprise o podemos destruir la luz.

Los Reyes Magos encuentran la Sagrada Familia. Vienen preparados para hacer este homenaje al recién nacido. Ellos traen regalos para un rey, a un Dios, para alguien que va a sufrir. Ellos pensaron en esto. Con demasiada frecuencia, no venimos a esta invitación a ver la luz con regalos que representan nuestra fe. Y, por lo que no nos proclamamos con nuestras vidas que creemos que Jesús es nuestro Señor y Dios, que es el que, en esta historia del evangelio, morirá por nuestros pecados. Sólo podemos imaginar lo que experimentaron María y José en esta revelación a los que están lejos Reyes Magos y de los regalos que traen para honrar a este niño de los suyos.


