HOW GOD INTENDS US TO LIVE

Today's readings are again directed to believers, communities of faith. As in last week's reading, Amos confronts us with a condemnation of those whose lives are focused on pleasure and self-absorption. The psalm contrasts that focus with the Lord's—justice for the oppressed; food the hungry; freedom for captives; sight to the blind; raising of those who are bowed down; loving the just; protecting strangers, orphans, and the widow; and by doing so, thwarting the way of the wicked. Timothy urges the pursuit of righteousness, devotion, faith, love, patience, and gentleness. Luke tells the familiar tale of the wealthy man and the poor beggar at his doorstep, who experience life very differently in this world and in the next. We are once again being given clear indications about how God intends for us to live our lives.

Las lecturas de hoy una vez más están dirigidas a los creyentes, comunidades de fe. Así como la lectura de la semana pasada. El Salmo contrasta ese enfoque con el del Señor: justicia para los oprimidos, alimentos para los hambrientos, libertad para los cautivos, vista para los ciegos, levantar a los agachados, amor al justo, proteger a los extranjeros, huérfanos y las viudas; y al hacerlo, frustrando el camino a los malvados. Timoteo nos insta a la búsqueda de la justicia, la devoción, la fe, el amor, la paciencia y la mansedumbre. Lucas cuenta la historia familiar de un hombre rico y un mendigo en su puerta, que lleva una vida muy diferente en este mundo y en el otro. Una vez más estamos recibiendo indicaciones acerca de cómo Dios quiere que vivamos nuestras vidas.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Since the 17th century, on October 2, the Church has celebrated the commemoration of the Holy Custodian Angels. Many of us know the image of a little boy and his little sister walking on a shaky and rotten bridge. Above them is on watch a beautiful creature, his protective angel. This image of beings with wings is one that Christians take from Roman and Greek pagans, since biblically speaking most of the angels have no wings. Lately angels have become fashionable among non-Christians, but we must not get carried away by their "new age" doctrines. Many of them seek to put the angels at their own service asking for money, their partner and other things. Angels do not exist to enrich us. Rather, we must know that angels are there to glorify and serve God and care for marginalized humans. Jesus himself tells us that we must take care to despise the little ones (poor and oppressed people) "because I assure you that your angels in heaven are constantly in the presence of my heavenly Father" (Matthew 18: 10-11).
