

RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD

Today's readings invite us into prayer, into relationship with God. Because relationships feel more natural when we know one another well, Sirach encourages us to know God better. In his wisdom, Sirach tells us what God is like: fair, open-minded, compassionate, and attentive. "The Lord will not delay," he says. Knowing that God's help comes right on time, whenever we need it, calms our hearts and helps us trust the Lord. In his second Letter to Timothy, Saint Paul demonstrates his own trust in God. Despite the grueling struggles Saint Paul has faced because of his Christian faith, he praises the Lord for rescuing him time and again. Today's Gospel draws us close to Jesus too, revealing his special love for the poor and humble. As Jesus tells his parable about the prayer habits of a Pharisee and a tax collector, our hearts long to become as gentle as Christ's.

En la segunda carta a Timoteo, san Pablo demuestra su propia confianza en Dios. A pesar de las luchas agotadoras que san Pablo ha enfrentado a causa de su fe cristiana, él alaba al Señor por haberlo rescatado una y otra vez. El Evangelio de hoy nos acerca también a Jesús, revelando su especial amor por los pobres y humildes. Cuando Jesús cuenta la parábola acerca de las formas como los fariseos y recolectores de impuestos rezan, nuestros corazones se convierten tan gentiles como los de Cristo.

On October 31, many are dressed as monsters and the next day, we Christians celebrate all the saints. The contrast between the two days is interesting. One day we remember witches and zombies and the next we commemorate virgins and martyrs, religious and laity all committed to one thing in common: their love for God, a love that becomes flesh in works of charity and justice. Most of the saints became saints thanks to the monsters that surrounded them. The first Christian martyrs died at the hands of Roman monsters, many medieval religious took refuge in God to protect themselves from internal monsters that tempted them with sex, money and power. And in America many like Manuel Chin Sooj became witnesses of justice in the hands of the monsters of unjust governments.

The monsters, in short, cannot defeat the saints that is why in Guatemala the martyrdom of Manuel Chin Sooj encouraged Guatemalan bishops to join with the letter "The Cry of the Earth" to the efforts of the poor in search of land and dignity human
