**XXIV Sunday of the Ordinary Time

Gospel**

Peter approached Jesus and asked him, "Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?" Jesus answered, "I say to you, not seven times but seventy-seven times. That is why the kingdom of heaven may be likened to a king who decided to settle accounts with his servants.

When he began the accounting, a debtor was brought before him who owed him a huge amount. Since he had no way of paying it back, his master ordered him to be sold, along with his wife, his children, and all his property, in payment of the debt. At that, the servant fell down, did him homage, and said, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back in full.' Moved with compassion the master of that servant let him go and forgave him the loan. When that servant had left, he found one of his fellow servants who owed him a much smaller amount. He seized him and started to choke him, demanding, 'Pay back what you owe.' Falling to his knees, his fellow servant begged him, 'Be patient with me, and I will pay you back.' But he refused. Instead, he had the fellow servant put in prison until he paid back the debt. Now when his fellow servants saw what had happened, they were deeply disturbed, and went to their master and reported the whole affair. His master summoned him and said to him, 'You wicked servant! I forgave you your entire debt because you begged me to. Should you not have had pity on your fellow servant, as I had pity on you?'

Then in anger his master handed him over to the torturers until he should pay back the whole debt. So will my heavenly Father do to you, unless each of you forgives your brother from your heart.

**XXIV Domingo de Tiempo Ordinario  
17 de Septiembre 2023  
Evangelio**

En aquel tiempo, Pedro se acercó a Jesús y le preguntó: "Si mi hermano me ofende, ¿cuántas veces tengo que perdonarlo? ¿Hasta siete veces?" Jesús le contestó: "No sólo hasta siete, sino hasta setenta veces siete". Entonces Jesús les dijo: "El Reino de los cielos es semejante a un rey que quiso ajustar cuentas con sus servidores. El primero que le presentaron le debía muchos millones. Como no tenía con qué pagar, el señor mandó que lo vendieran a él, a su mujer, a sus hijos y todas sus posesiones, para saldar la deuda. El servidor, arrojándose a sus pies, le suplicaba, diciendo: 'Ten paciencia conmigo y te lo pagaré todo'. El rey tuvo lástima de aquel servidor, lo soltó y hasta le perdonó la deuda.

Pero, apenas había salido aquel servidor, se encontró con uno de sus compañeros, que le debía poco dinero. Entonces lo agarró por el cuello y casi lo estrangulaba, mientras le decía: 'Págame lo que me debes'. El compañero se le arrodilló y le rogaba: 'Ten paciencia conmigo y te lo pagaré todo'. Pero el otro no quiso escucharlo, sino que fue y lo metió en la cárcel hasta que le pagara la deuda.

Al ver lo ocurrido, sus compañeros se llenaron de indignación y fueron a contar al rey lo sucedido. Entonces el señor lo llamó y le dijo: 'Siervo malvado. Te perdoné toda aquella deuda porque me lo suplicaste. ¿No debías tú también haber tenido compasión de tu compañero, como yo tuve compasión de ti?' Y el señor, encolerizado, lo entregó a los verdugos para que no lo soltaran hasta que pagara lo que debía. Pues lo mismo hará mi Padre celestial con ustedes, si cada cual no perdona de corazón a su hermano".

## Understanding the Bible

The Bible is all around us. People hear Scripture readings in church. We have Good Samaritan (Luke 10) laws, welcome home the Prodigal Son (Luke 15), and look for the Promised Land (Exodus 3, Hebrews 11). Some biblical passages have become popular maxims, such as "Do unto others as you would have them do unto you" (Matthew 7:12), "Thou shalt not steal" (Exodus 20:15), and "love thy neighbor" (Matthew 22:39).

Today's Catholic is called to take an intelligent, spiritual approach to the bible. Listed

here are 5 points for fruitful Scripture reading.

1. **Bible reading is for Catholics.** The Church encourages Catholics to make reading the Bible part of their daily prayer lives. Reading these inspired words, people grow deeper in their relationship with God and come to understand their place in the community God has called them to in himself.

2. **Prayer is the beginning and the end.** Reading the Bible is not like reading a novel or a history book. It should begin with a prayer asking the Holy Spirit to open our hearts and minds to the Word of God. Scripture reading should end with a prayer that this Word will bear fruit in our lives, helping us to become holier and more faithful people.

3. **Get the whole story! When selecting a Bible, look for a Catholic edition.** A Catholic edition will include the Church's complete list of sacred books along with introductions and notes for understanding the text. A Catholic edition will have an *imprimatur* notice on the back of the title page. An *imprimatur* indicates that the book is free of errors in Catholic doctrine.

4. **The Bible isn't a book. It's a library.** The Bible is a collection of 73 books written over the course of many centuries. The books include royal history, prophecy, poetry, challenging letters to struggling new faith communities, and believers' accounts of the preaching and passion of Jesus. Knowing the genre of the book you are reading will help you understand the literary tools the author is using and the meaning the author is trying to convey.

5. **Know what the Bible is – and what it isn't.** The Bible is the story of God's relationship with the people he has called to himself. It is not intended to be read as history text, a science book, or a political manifesto. In the Bible, God teaches us the truths that we need for the sake of our salvation.

## Entendiendo la Biblia

La Biblia está a nuestro alrededor. La gente escucha lecturas de las Escrituras en la iglesia. Tenemos leyes del Buen Samaritano (Lucas 10), damos la bienvenida a casa al Hijo Pródigo (Lucas 15) y buscamos la Tierra Prometida (Éxodo 3, Hebreos 11). Algunos pasajes bíblicos se han convertido en máximas populares, como "Haz a los demás lo que quisieras que te hicieran a ti" (Mateo 7:12), "No robarás" (Éxodo 20:15) y "Amarás a tu prójimo" (Mateo 22:39). El católico de hoy está llamado a adoptar un enfoque inteligente y espiritual de la Biblia.

Aquí se enumeran 5 puntos para la lectura fructífera de las Escrituras.

1. **La lectura de la Biblia es para los católicos.** La Iglesia anima a los católicos a hacer de la lectura de la Biblia parte de su vida diaria de oración. Al leer estas palabras inspiradas, las personas crecen más profundamente en su relación con Dios y llegan a comprender su lugar en la comunidad a la que Dios los ha llamado en sí mismo.

2. **La oración es el principio y el fin.** Leer la Biblia no es como leer una novela o un libro de historia. Debe comenzar con una oración pidiéndole al Espíritu Santo que abra nuestros corazones y mentes a la Palabra de Dios. La lectura de las Escrituras debe terminar con una oración para que esta Palabra dé fruto en nuestras vidas, ayudándonos a ser personas más santas y fieles.

3. **¡Obtén toda la historia! Al seleccionar una Biblia, busque una edición católica.** Una edición católica incluirá la lista completa de libros sagrados de la Iglesia junto con introducciones y notas para comprender el texto. Una edición católica tendrá un *aviso de imprimatur* en la parte posterior de la página del título. Un *imprimatur* indica que el libro está libre de errores en la doctrina católica.

4. **La Biblia no es un libro. Es una biblioteca.** La Biblia es una colección de 73 libros escritos a lo largo de muchos siglos. Los libros incluyen historia real, profecía, poesía, cartas desafiantes a nuevas comunidades de fe que luchan y relatos de creyentes sobre la predicación y la pasión de Jesús. Conocer el género del libro que estás leyendo te ayudará a comprender las herramientas literarias que el autor está utilizando y el significado que el autor está tratando de transmitir.

5. **Sepa lo que es la Biblia y lo que no es.** La Biblia es la historia de la relación de Dios con las personas que él ha llamado a sí mismo. No está destinado a ser leído como un texto de historia, un libro de ciencia o un manifiesto político. En la Biblia, Dios nos enseña las verdades que necesitamos por el bien de nuestra salvación.
