Understanding the Liturgical Colors

In the liturgical calendar, the color for each day corresponds to that day's main liturgical celebration, even though Optional Memorials (perhaps with a different color) might be chosen instead. The four main colors shown are:

White – Christmas Time and Easter Time; celebrations of the Lord (except of his Passion), of Mary, of the Angels, and of Saints who were not Martyrs; solemnities of the Most Holy Trinity (Sun. after Pentecost), of All Saints (Nov. 1), and of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist (June 24); feasts of the Conversion of St. Paul (Jan. 25), of the Chair of St. Peter (Feb. 22), and of St. John (Dec. 27); also permitted in the United States at Masses for the Dead

Red – Palm Sunday, Good Friday, and Pentecost Sunday; celebrations of the Lord's Passion, of Apostles, and of Evangelists; celebrations of Martyrs

Green – Ordinary Time

Violet – Advent and Lent; Masses for the Dead
Other liturgical colors not represented on this calendar include rose (Third Sun. of Advent and Fourth Sun. of Lent), black (Masses for the Dead), and gold or silver (permitted in the United States for more solemn occasions).

Conociendo los Colores Liturgicos

En el calendario litúrgico, el color de cada día corresponde a la celebración litúrgica principal de ese día, aunque en su lugar se pueden elegir Memorias Facultativas (tal vez con un color diferente). Los cuatro colores principales que se muestran son:

Blanco: tiempo de Navidad y tiempo de Pascua; celebraciones del Señor (excepto de su Pasión), de María, de los Ángeles y de los Santos que no fueron Mártires; solemnidades de la Santísima Trinidad (domingo después de Pentecostés), de Todos los Santos (1 de noviembre) y de la Natividad de San Juan Bautista (24 de junio); fiestas de la Conversión de San Pablo (25 de enero), de la Cátedra de San Pedro (22 de febrero) y de San Juan (27 de diciembre); también se permite en los Estados Unidos en las Misas de Difuntos

Rojo – Domingo de Ramos, Viernes Santo y Domingo de Pentecostés; celebraciones de la Pasión del Señor, de los Apóstoles y de los Evangelistas; celebraciones de los Mártires.

Verde – Tiempo Ordinario

Violeta – Adviento y Cuaresma; Misas de difuntos
Otros colores litúrgicos que no están representados en este calendario son el rosa (Tercer Sol de Adviento y Cuarto Sol de Cuaresma), el negro (Misas de Difuntos) y el oro o la plata (permitidos en los Estados Unidos para ocasiones más solemnes).

The Catholic Church proclaims that human life is sacred and that the dignity of the human person is the foundation of a moral vision for society. This belief is the foundation of all the principles of our social teaching. In our society, human life is under direct attack from [abortion](#) and [euthanasia](#). The value of human life is being threatened by [cloning](#), [embryonic stem cell research](#), and the use of the [death penalty](#). The intentional targeting of civilians in [war](#) or terrorist attacks is always wrong. Catholic teaching also calls on us to work to avoid war. Nations must protect the right to life by finding increasingly effective ways to prevent conflicts and [resolve them by peaceful means](#). We believe that every person is precious, that people are more important than things, and that the measure of every institution is whether it threatens or enhances the [life and dignity](#) of the human person.
