2025 Lenten Regulations For the Diocese of Santa Rosa

"The Lenten Season has a double character, namely to prepare both catechumens and faithful to celebrate the paschal mystery. **The Catechumens**, both with the Rite of Election and Scrutiny, and by catechesis, are prepared for a celebration of the sacraments of Christian Initiation; the **faithful**, ever more attentive to the Word of God and prayer, prepare themselves by penance for the renewal of their baptism promises" (The Order of Prayer in the Liturgy of the Hours and the Celebration of the Eucharist)

The current discipline is as follows:

- * Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of **fast and abstinence**, that is, limited to a single, full meal and abstinence from meat.
- * The other Friday of Lent are days of abstinence from meat.
- * The law of **fasting** permits only one full meal a day, but it does allow the taking of some food in the morning and a second light meal at noon or in the evening, as you prefer. Persons who have completed their eighteen year of the beginning or their sixtieth (60) year are obligated to fast.
- * The law of **abstinence** from meat applies to all persons who have completed their fourteenth year of age. However, it is highly recommended the children from ages seven to fourteenth years also follow the law of **abstinence**.
- * All Catholics are encouraged to receive Holy Eucharist frequently during lent and receive the Sacrament of Penance so that all may be prepared to celebrate more fully the paschal mystery. Those who have received their first Holy Communion are to receive Holy Communion during Easter season.
- * The determination of those days of obligatory Penance as listed above, should not be understood as limiting the occasions for Christian Penance. This Penance is to help us see and shorten the distance between our present lives and the life God wants for each of us. "Penance should not be internal and individual but external and social"
- * **Marriages** may be celebrated with mass and the nuptial blessing should always be given. It is, however, contrary to the spirit of Penance during Lent to plan an elaborate wedding with lavish decorations.

Reglamento de Cuaresma 2025 para la Diócesis de Santa Rosa

"El tiempo de Cuaresma tiene un doble carácter, saber, preparar tanto a los catecúmenos como a los fieles para celebrar el misterio pascual. Los catecúmenos, tanto con el Rito de Elección y Escrutinio, como por la catequesis, se preparan para la celebración de los sacramentos de la Iniciación Cristiana; los fieles, cada vez más atentos a la Palabra de Dios y a la oración, se preparan con la penitencia para la renovación de sus promesas bautismales" (Orden de la oración en la Liturgia de las Horas y en la Celebración de la Eucaristía)

La disciplina actual es la siguiente:

- * El Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo son días de **ayuno y abstinencia**, es decir, limitados a una sola comida completa y abstinencia de carne.
- * Los otros viernes de Cuaresma son días de **abstinencia** de carne.
- * La ley del **ayuno** permite solo una comida completa al día, pero permite tomar algo de comida por la mañana y una segunda comida ligera al mediodía o por la noche, como prefieras. Las personas que hayan cumplido los dieciocho años y hasta los sesenta (60) años están obligadas a ayunar.
- * La ley de **abstinencia** de carne se aplica a todas las personas que hayan cumplido los catorce años de edad. Sin embargo, es muy recomendable que los niños de siete a catorce años también sigan la ley de **abstinencia**.
- * Se anima a todos los católicos a recibir la Sagrada Eucaristía con frecuencia durante la Cuaresma y recibir el Sacramento de la Penitencia para que todos estén preparados para celebrar más plenamente el misterio pascual. Aquellos que han recibido su Primera Comunión deben recibir la Sagrada Comunión durante la temporada de Pascua.
- * La determinación de los días de penitencia obligatoria enumerados anteriormente, no debe entenderse como una limitación de las ocasiones para la penitencia cristiana. Esta Penitencia es para ayudarnos a ver y acortar la distancia entre nuestras vidas presentes y la vida que Dios quiere para cada uno de nosotros. "La penitencia no debe ser interna e individual, sino externa y social"
- * **Los matrimonios** pueden celebrarse con misa y siempre se debe dar la bendición nupcial. Sin embargo, es contrario al espíritu de la Penitencia durante la Cuaresma planear una boda elaborada con decoraciones lujosas.


