✦ Reflection for The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity – Year C

“The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.” – 2 Corinthians 13:13

One day, Saint Augustine was walking along the seashore, reflecting on the mystery of the Holy Trinity. He saw a young boy digging a hole in the sand and running back and forth to the ocean with a little seashell, pouring water into the hole.

Augustine asked, “What are you doing?” The boy replied, “I’m going to put the whole ocean into this hole!” Augustine smiled and said, “But that’s impossible — the ocean is too vast, too deep, too wide.” And the boy looked at him and said, “And neither can you fit the mystery of God into your tiny mind.” Then the boy vanished many believe it was an angel sent to remind Augustine (and all of us) that God’s mystery is not to be solved, but adored.

This is what we celebrate today: the Most Holy Trinity one God in three Persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. This is not a math formula, but a living mystery the mystery of a God who is love.

In today’s Gospel (John 16:12–15), Jesus shows us this unity of love when He says, “Everything that the Father has is mine. The Spirit will take from what is mine and declare it to you.”

Here we see perfect communion: the Father gives all to the Son, the Son shares it with the Spirit, and the Spirit brings it to us.

Saint Paul says in Romans 5:5,

“God’s love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit.”

So what does this mean?

The Father created us in love.

The Son saves us through love.

The Spirit fills us with love.

The Holy Trinity is not far away. In baptism, we were drawn into that divine life. Every time we pray “In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit,” we proclaim that we belong to God a God who is not loneliness, but a family of love.

As Saint Elizabeth of the Trinity once said: *“Let yourself be loved more than these words can say.”* And if God is relationship, Father, Son, and Spirit then we are made for relationship: for communion, for community, for love. Our families, our friendships, our parish all are called to mirror the divine harmony of God.

So today, instead of trying to “figure out” the Trinity, let’s open our hearts to it. Let it inspire us to live in love, in unity, and in peace the way God lives in Himself.

Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit.

As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.

Jubilee of Marriage – Saturday, July 26 & 27, 2025

The Bishops of California have declared **Saturday, July 26, 2025**, as the **Jubilee of Marriage** during this **Jubilee Year of Hope**. Marriage is a profound sign of hope, and the bishops have chosen the feast of **St. Joachim and Anne** as a fitting occasion to affirm and support this vocation.

In **Bishop Vasa’s** message, he emphasized the importance of the **Plenary Indulgence** available to the faithful in the Diocese of Santa Rosa:

“Plenary Indulgences in the Diocese of Santa Rosa can be received at any parish if the requirements are fulfilled.

One of the requirements for gaining an indulgence is an authentic freedom from any and all attachment to sin, even venial sin. Being free from sin after confession is a lot different than being free from an attachment to venial sin. Yet the Church is quite explicit:

‘It is further required that all attachment to sin, even to venial sin, be absent. If this disposition is in any way less than complete ... the indulgence will only be partial.’”


