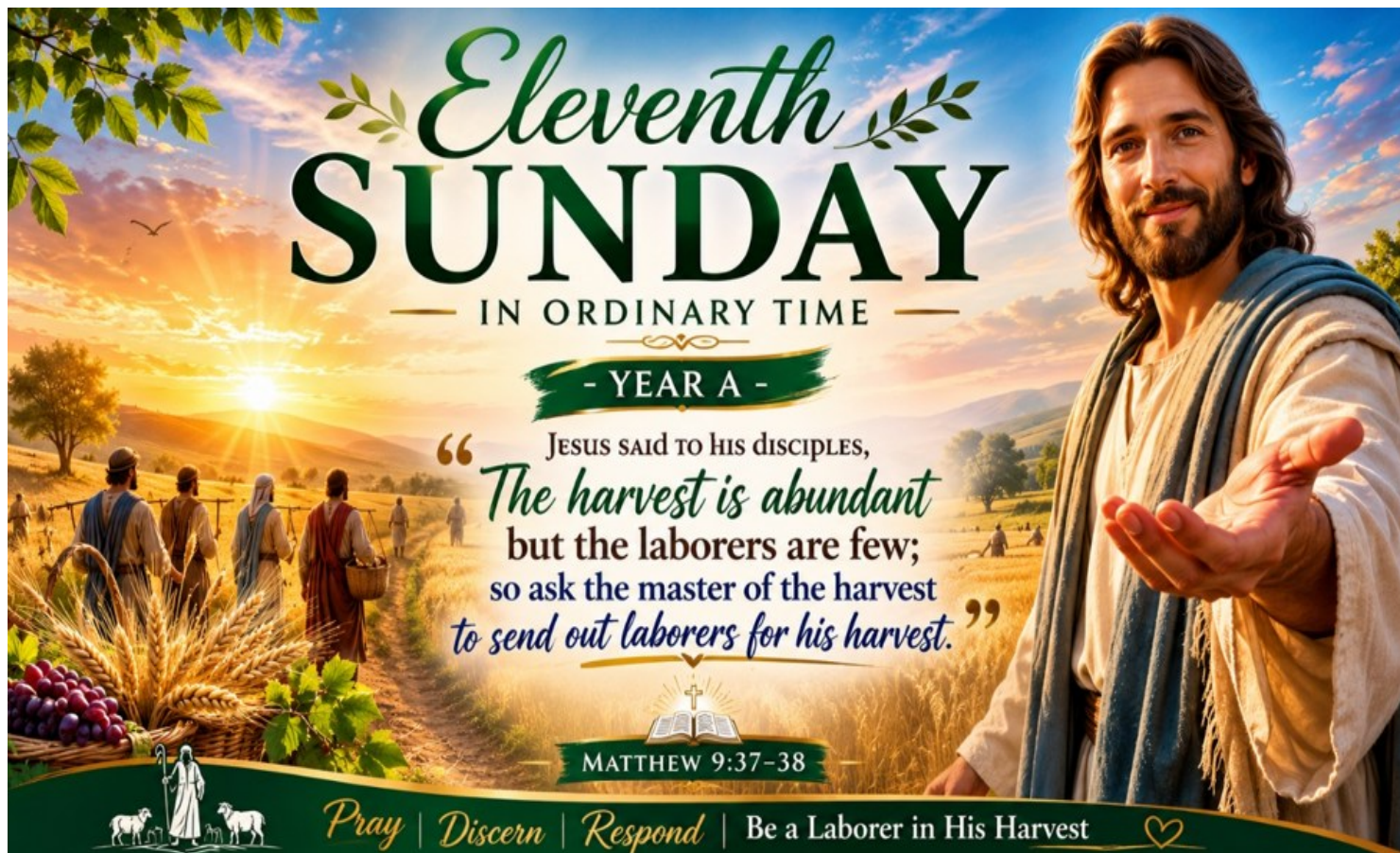

Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year A
“The harvest is abundant, but the laborers are few.” (Matthew 9:37)

As Jesus looked upon the crowds, He was filled with compassion because they were like “sheep without a shepherd.” Looking at the world today, we can see the same reality. Many people are searching for hope, truth, purpose, and God's love. The harvest remains abundant.

Jesus' solution is surprising, He says, **“Ask the master of the harvest to send out laborers for his harvest.”** The Church's mission begins with prayer and continues through generous discipleship.

Pope **St. John Paul II** reminded the Church in *Redemptoris Missio* that the missionary task is still far from complete and that every baptized Christian shares responsibility for proclaiming Christ. Likewise, Pope **Francis** often speaks of the Church as a “missionary Church” that goes forth to encounter those on the margins.

The harvest today is not only in distant lands; it is in our own homes, workplaces, schools, and parish communities. We are all called to be laborers through prayer, kindness, service, and a joyful witness to our faith.

This Sunday, let us pray for vocations to the priesthood and religious life, and let us ask the Lord: **“How are You calling me to work in Your harvest?”**

“The world promises success; Christ calls us to fruitfulness.” May we answer His call with generous hearts.

Pope Leo XIV's First Encyclical

Pope Leo XIV's first encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas* (“The Greatness of Humanity”), reflects deeply on the dignity of the human person in the age of artificial intelligence. Inspired by Pope Leo XIII's *Rerum Novarum*, the Holy Father reminds the world that technology must always serve humanity, never replace or dominate it.

The encyclical calls for the protection of human dignity, truth, family life, justice, and peace in a rapidly changing digital world. Pope Leo XIV warns against a culture where profit, power, and technology overshadow compassion, morality, and human relationships. He invites all people to build a civilization rooted not in machines and control, but in love, solidarity, and the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Holy Father beautifully reminds us that even in an age of advanced technology, the human heart, conscience, and soul remain sacred gifts from God.

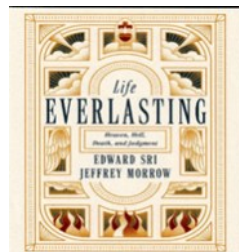

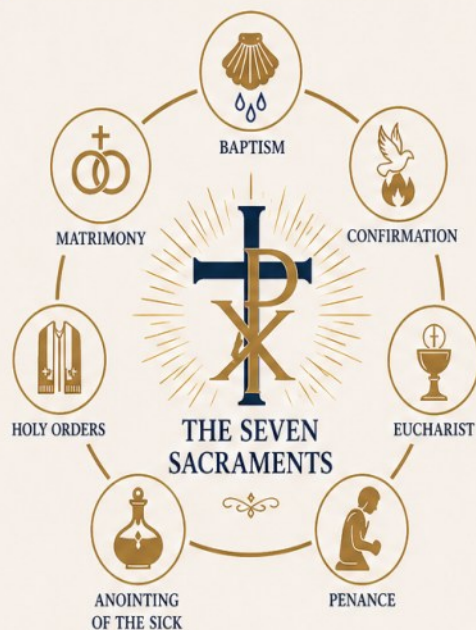
