Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year A Father's Day Reflection

In today's Gospel (Matthew 10:26-33), Jesus repeats a simple but powerful message: **"Do not be afraid."**

He reminds us that we are precious in the eyes of God. Even the hairs of our head are counted, and we are worth far more than many sparrows.

Fear is one of the greatest struggles of our time. We worry about our families, our future, our health, and our world. Yet Jesus invites us to trust in the loving care of our Heavenly Father. Faith does not remove every difficulty, but it gives us the courage to walk through them knowing that God never abandons us. As we celebrate Father's Day, we give thanks for all fathers, grandfathers, stepfathers, and father figures who reflect God's love through their sacrifice, protection, guidance, and generosity. A good father teaches not only by words but by example. His presence reminds us of the tenderness and strength of God our Father.

Today, let us pray for all fathers: that they may be blessed with wisdom, patience, and faith. Let us also remember those fathers who have gone before us to the Lord and those who carry the responsibilities of fatherhood with quiet dedication.

May the words of Jesus echo in our hearts this week: **"Do not be afraid; you are worth more than many sparrows."** When we know that we are loved by God, fear loses its power, hope is renewed, and we find the strength to live as faithful children of our Heavenly Father.

800th Anniversary of the Death of the Poverello of Assisi

The Peace Prayer of Saint Francis

Dear Parishioners,

Pope Leo XIV has proclaimed a special Jubilee Year in honor of Saint Francis of Assisi, running from January 10, 2026 to January 10, 2027, marking the 800th anniversary of his death. All the faithful are invited to follow the example of the “Poor Man of Assisi” becoming models of holiness and witnesses of peace in our own time.

Born around 1181 in Assisi, Italy, Francis abandoned wealth and privilege to embrace a life of radical poverty, prayer, and service to the poor. His love for creation, his commitment to peace, and his joyful surrender to God's will made him one of the most beloved saints in the history of the Church. Pope Francis, who carried his name, once called him “a model of care for the vulnerable and of an integral ecology lived out joyfully.”

The Peace Prayer attributed to Saint Francis though composed in the early 20th century in his spirit beautifully captures his heart: a longing not to be consoled, but to console; not to be loved, but to love. During this Jubilee Year, let us make this prayer our own, and allow it to shape the way we live, serve, and love one another in our parish community.

*where there is sadness, **joy.***

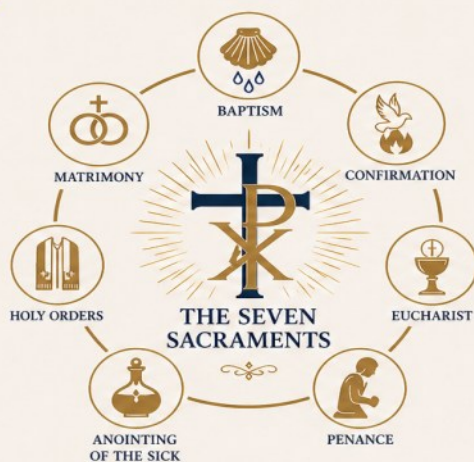
O Divine Master, grant that I may not so much seek
