The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)

The Feast of Corpus Christi invites us to reflect on the greatest gift Jesus has given to His Church: Himself in the Holy Eucharist.

At the Last Supper, Jesus took bread and said, "This is my body given for you" (Luke 22:19). At every Mass, this same Jesus becomes truly present for us under the appearances of bread and wine. The Eucharist is not merely a symbol; it is the Real Presence of Christ—His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity.

Jesus promises, "I am the living bread that came down from heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever" (John 6:51). In the Eucharist, He nourishes our souls, strengthens us in our struggles, comforts us in our sorrows, and draws us closer to God and to one another.

St. Thomas Aquinas called the Eucharist the "**Sacrament of Love.**" Every time we receive Holy Communion with faith and reverence, Christ comes to dwell within us and transforms our hearts.

As we celebrate Corpus Christi, let us renew our love for Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. May we participate faithfully in Holy Mass, spend time in Eucharistic Adoration, and become what we receive—the Body of Christ for the life of the world.

"O Sacrament Most Holy, O Sacrament Divine, all praise and all thanksgiving be every moment Thine." Amen.

Pope Leo XIV's First Encyclical

Pope Leo XIV's first encyclical, *Magnifica Humanitas* ("The Greatness of Humanity"), reflects deeply on the dignity of the human person in the age of artificial intelligence. Inspired by Pope Leo XIII's *Rerum Novarum*, the Holy Father reminds the world that technology must always serve humanity, never replace or dominate it.

The encyclical calls for the protection of human dignity, truth, family life, justice, and peace in a rapidly changing digital world. Pope Leo XIV warns against a culture where profit, power, and technology overshadow compassion, morality, and human relationships. He invites all people to build a civilization rooted not in machines and control, but in love, solidarity, and the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Holy Father beautifully reminds us that even in an age of advanced technology, the human heart, conscience, and soul remain sacred gifts from God.

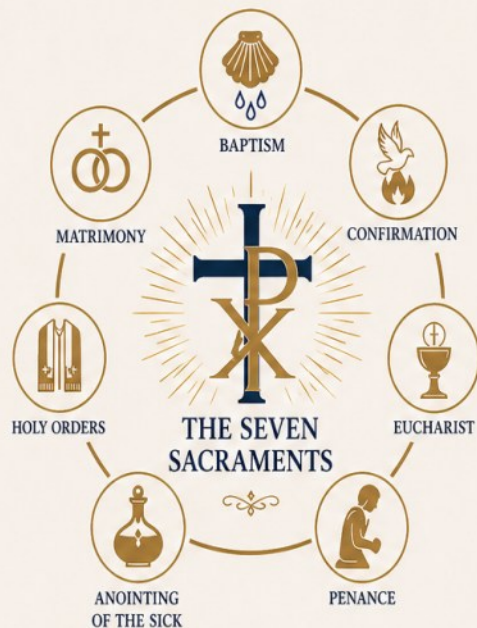
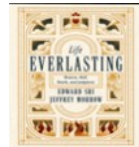
