Pastor's Reflection

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time – Year A

Patience That Gives Hope

We live in a world that wants everything to happen immediately. We expect quick answers, quick success, and quick solutions. Yet Jesus tells us a different story.

In today's Gospel, the servants want to pull out the weeds right away. But the master says, "**Let both grow together until the harvest.**" God sees what we cannot see. He knows that if we act too quickly, we may harm the good along with the bad.

How often do we become impatient with ourselves or with others? We may judge a person because of one mistake, or lose hope because someone has not changed. But God is patient. He never gives up on His children. His mercy always leaves room for repentance, healing, and new life.

The first reading reminds us that God's power is shown not by harshness, but by mercy. St. Paul adds that even when we do not know how to pray, the Holy Spirit prays within us. God is always working quietly in our hearts, even when we cannot see it.

Like the tiny mustard seed and the little yeast in the Gospel, God's Kingdom often begins in small and hidden ways. A kind word, a sincere prayer, an act of forgiveness, or a helping hand may seem small, but God can use these simple acts to transform lives.

This week, let us be patient—with ourselves, with others, and with God's timing. Trust that the Lord is still at work. In His hands, every seed of goodness will one day bear a rich and abundant harvest.

****We encourage gentlemen to remove hats or caps inside the church, unless needed for medical reasons.**

Parents are kindly asked to help their children dress appropriately for Mass.

This reminder is offered not to judge anyone, but to help preserve the reverence and dignity of the Sacred Liturgy. Everyone is always welcome in God's house. Together, let us honor the Lord with both our hearts and our outward appearance as we gather to celebrate the Holy Eucharist.
